How are the surrounding regions preparing?

Companies:

- Regional development projects since 2010 (ongoing e.g. P-P Verkkopalvelut)
- Carried out by municipal economic development organisations
- In co-operation with other regional development projects, the surrounding municipalities, Chamber of Commerce, entrepreneur associations, Fennovoima, STUK and the power plant project suppliers
- The development projects aim to support the local companies in order to acquire necessary information and know how concerning the nuclear power plant construction project
- Coaching in co-operation with e.g. FinNuclear Ry
- Information about e.g. quality and documentation in nuclear power plant projects.

Public sector:

- Enhancing the abilities of the public sector to answer to the needs rising from the activities regarding the major investment projects in the area. (e.g. Hanhikivi-yhteyshanke v. 2012-2015, Hanhikivi-jatkoyhteyshanke 2015-2017)
- Efficient preparing enables maximising the positive effects of the major projects for the region
- Systematic exchange of information in different regional working groups; Hanhikivi-working group, Cross regional co-operation group, educational institutes co-operation network, Hanhikivi service centre working group.

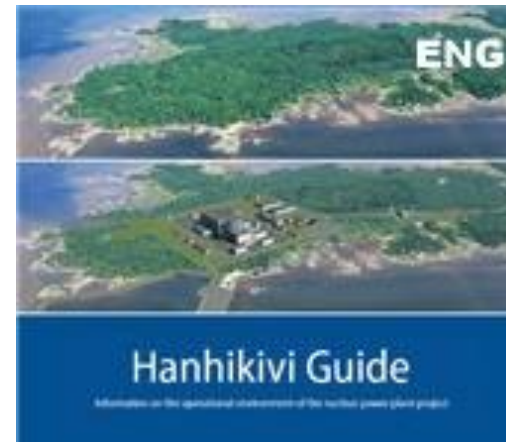

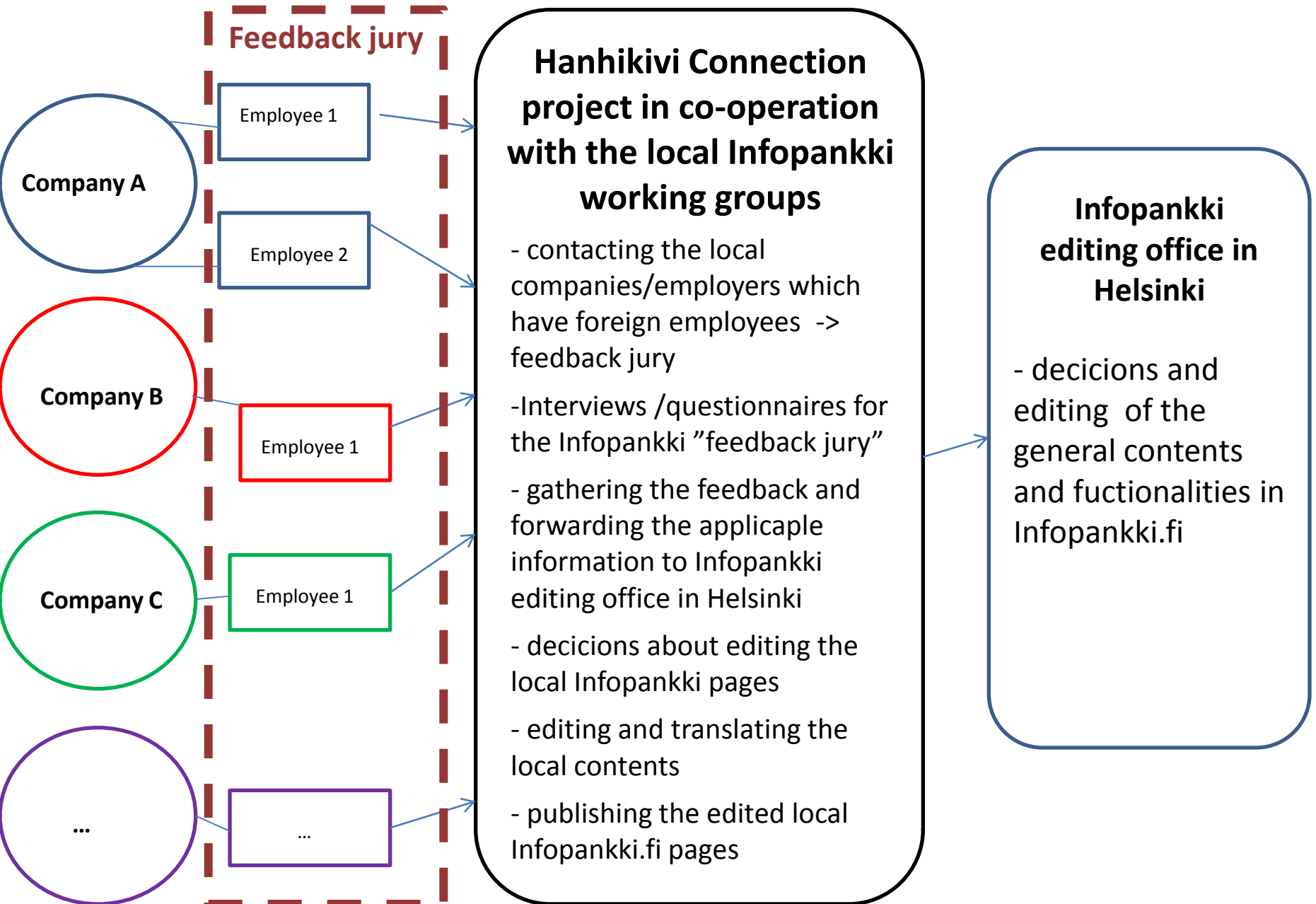

1) Hanhikivi service centre's processes especially regarding foreign employees and their settling to the area. The planning is carried out in co-operation with the regional and state public authorities, Fennovoima, RAOS Voima, RAOS Project, Titan-2 and municipal representatives. The Hanhikivi service centre working group gathers approx. once a month or two.

2) Developing the Infopankki.fi contents to serve even better the needs of the foreign employees moving to the area. The development is carried out in co-operation with Infopankki.fi editing office, the local companies and their foreign employees in the area.
